Set amidst stunning mountains, Crianlarich Youth Hostel is just over an hour's drive from Stirling. It's a great base for anyone looking to explore the northern area of the Loch Lomond and Trossachs National Park.

Rooms

Capacity 50:

- 1 triple (en-suite with disabled access)
- 3 four-bedded (1 en-suite, 2 with double beds)
- 3 six-bedded
- 17 dorm beds

All rooms have washbasins. Room configurations may be subject to occasional change

Reception

Apr-Oct

- Open 07.00-10.00 and 15.00-22.00
- Check-in from 15.00
- Checkout by 10.00

Nov-Mar

- Open 07.00-10.00 and 17.00-22.00
- Check-in from 17.00
- Checkout by 10.00

Late arrival and access outside opening hours is by pre-arrangement only

Catering

- Continental breakfast is served between 07.30-09.00
- Packed lunches are available
- Full catering is available for groups of 20 and over
- We can provide self-catering frozen meals - book online or before 22.00 on your day of arrival

Self-catering

- Kitchen is open between 07.00-10.30 and 15.30-23.15 and has space for 6 people
- 4 hobs (gas), 2 domestic ovens, 2 fridges and 1 microwave
- Selection of pots to cater for individuals and groups
- Crockery and cutlery available to suit staggered meal times for all guests
- Dining room can seat 53 people
- We are fully licensed, selling a selection of beer, wine and cider

Facilities

- There is a small lounge (with TV) which can seat 23 people
- Coin-operated washing/drying machine

- Medium-sized drying room (free of charge)
- Towel hire available
- Free internet and Wi-Fi access

Security

There are locks on all rooms

Shopping

Small stock of food supplies available, including savoury rice, organic pasta, sauces, cereals, milk and hot chocolate

Other goods available include blister packs, earplugs, midge repellent, personal hygiene products, towel hire and map hire. We also sell alcohol

Directions

A82 from Glasgow-Crianlarich: at the roundabout take the second junction on the left, heading for Crianlarich Village. Turn right at T-junction A85, then first right past the village shop and continue up Station Road

The youth hostel is 100m on the left after the local shop. If you miss the A82 south roundabout, you can access the village from the west - just follow the signs for Crianlarich Village, go under the railway bridge, pass the T-junction, go under the railway viaduct and take the first right junction - we are up the road on the left

From A85 from Stirling-Crianlarich: take the first junction on the left after the police station. Continue up Station Road and the youth hostel is 100m on the left after the local shop.

Parking

- Car park in front of the youth hostel will hold around 23 cars, or 2 coaches and fewer cars
- Secure cycle storage for up to 16 (100m from main building)

Local activities

Crianlarich Youth Hostel has 20 Munros in the vicinity. It's also a key location for the West Highland Way. Crianlarich Woodland Walk and Cruach Ardrain Munro start from the youth hostel. Ben More and Sob Binnien are 3 miles to the east

There are regular visits from steam trains in the summer. St Fillan Priory and Dalrigh Battlefield site are 4 miles away

Other activities nearby, or within an hour's drive, include fishing on the River Fillan, Loch Dochart and River Dochart (permits can be bought locally)

There is golf at Killin and Dalmally and gold panning in Tyndrum. The nearest Tourist Information Centre is in Tyndrum

Accessibility

Crianlarich Youth Hostel is suitable for people with impaired mobility:

- Disabled access is good, with ramped access to the youth hostel and the front door can extend when required
- Wheelchairs and buggies have excellent access and a triple en-suite room (1 bunk + 1 single) with disabled facilities is available on the ground floor (please check availability at time of booking)
- There is an extra toilet facility on the ground floor opposite reception
