Capacity 86:

Dorms

- 2 eight-bedded
- 1 eleven-bedded
- 2 sixteen-bedded

Private rooms

- 1 single (with washbasin)
- 1 double (with washbasin)
- 2 two-bedded (1 with washbasin)
- 2 three-bedded (1 en-suite)
- 2 four-bedded
- 1 six-bedded

There are 12 showers and 15 toilets. Room configurations may be subject to occasional change

Reception

- Open 07.00-10.00 and 15.00-23.00
- Check-in from 15.00
- Checkout by 10.00

Late arrival is by pre-arrangement only

Day access to some areas of the hostel will be available – please check with the hostel on the day

Catering

- Continental breakfast, cooked breakfast and packed lunches available for individual guests throughout the year
- Continental breakfast, cooked breakfast, packed lunches and evening meals available for groups of over 10 people as long as they're pre-booked more than 2 weeks prior to arrival
- Breakfast is normally served at an agreed time between 07.30-08.30
- We are fully licenced to sell alcohol

Self-catering

- Kitchen has space for 15 people
- 5 hobs with 23 cooking rings (gas), 2 ovens, 2 fridges (no freezer) and 1 microwave
- Selection of pots to cater for individuals and groups
- Crockery and cutlery available to suit staggered meal times for all guests
- Kitchen is open from 07.00-10.00 and 15.15-22.30
- The dining room can seat 35 people

Facilities

- One small lounge on the ground floor will accommodate 15 people
- Coin-operated washing and drying machine is usually available from 15.00-22.00
- Large drying room available free of charge
- Free internet/Wi-Fi access in the public areas

Security

Swipe card operated locks to the rooms/dorms

Shopping

Glen Nevis Youth Hostel sells a good selection of soft drinks, alcoholic beverages and confectionery. Maps, batteries and postcards are also available

There's a large supermarket nearby in Fort William which is open 7 days

Directions

Car: from Fort William follow the A82 to the mini roundabout and continue straight ahead for Glen Nevis. The youth hostel is 3 miles along this road and past the Ben Nevis visitor centre

- Official coach parking is available in the West End Car Park, Fort William
- If space permits, roadside parking may be available
- There's secure cycle storage for up to 15 bicycles at the rear of the building

Local activities

The climb to Ben Nevis, the highest mountain in Scotland (and the UK) is directly opposite the entrance to the youth hostel. The West Highland Way also ends here. It's a great base for winter sports as well as summer

Fort William regularly hosts the World Mountain Bike Championships and has biking routes for all abilities in the vicinity.

There's a good selection of bars and restaurants in Fort William if you still have some energy in the evening!
