Capacity 163:

- 4 singles (en-suite)
 - 7 twins (en-suite)
 - 1 double (en-suite)
 - 1 three-bedded (en-suite)
 - 4 four-bedded (en-suite)
 - 12 four-bedded (with basin)
 - 2 five-bedded (with basin)
 - 1 six-bedded (en-suite)
 - 10 six-bedded (with basin)

Reception

- Open 07.00-23.00
- Check-in from 15.00 with a night porter available for late check-in to 02.00
- Checkout by 10.00

Access outside opening hours is by pre-arrangement only

Catering

Full catering service available. We can provide continental or full Scottish breakfasts, packed lunches and a choice of 1, 2 or 3 course evening meals which are freshly prepared on the premises

- Coffees, teas and light snacks available throughout the day
- Breakfast served from 07.30-09.00 and evening meals at an agreed time between 17.30-20.00
- The dining room can seat 65 people

To avoid disappointment, please reserve meals at the time of booking, or at least 4 weeks prior to arrival

Self-catering

- Kitchen has space for 10 people
- 6 hobs (gas and electric), with 3 domestic ovens, 2 fridges and 2 microwaves, 2 toasters
- Selection of pots to cater for individuals and groups
- Crockery and cutlery available to suit staggered meal times for all guests
- Kitchen is open from 06.30-10.00 and 15.00-23.00 (closed for cleaning between 10.00-15.00)
- The dining room can seat 35 people, but is not suitable for large groups

Facilities

- Lounge, with TV, which can seat 30 people
- Our small meeting room can be booked by contacting the youth hostel directly
- Two coin-operated washing and drying machines are available from 16.00-23.00
- Free Wi-Fi access

Directions

Bus: from Inverness Bus Station turn left onto Academy Street. Keep left and follow road around the corner past the shopping centre. Go past Morrisons supermarket and take the first road on the right (Victoria Drive). Inverness Youth Hostel is halfway up the hill on the left (10 minute walk)

Train: from Inverness Station turn left onto Academy Street. Keep left and follow road around the corner past the shopping centre. Go past Morrisons supermarket and take the first road on the right (Victoria Drive). The youth hostel is halfway up the hill on the left (10 minute walk)

Car:

from A9 south & north - leave the A9 at junction signposted for Aberdeen and Nairn (A96). At the roundabout take B865 into the town centre (first exit) and pass the Thistle Hotel straight ahead at the mini roundabout. Victoria Drive is the second road on the left

from A82 - follow the road through the town centre. Take fourth exit at Shore Street roundabout. Follow this road (Academy Street), round the corner (at M&S) and past Morrisons supermarket. Victoria Drive is first on the right

Parking

There is parking adjoining the youth hostel for up to 30 cars. Coach access is subject to availability

Local activities

Inverness has something for everyone, from 'Nessie Spotting' on world-famous Loch Ness to the historical site of nearby Culloden Moor. Inverness also has excellent shopping, theatre and music

Accessibility

Inverness Youth Hostel has a room in the west wing suitable for guests with impaired mobility, as well as an accessible toilet. The ground floor also has ramps so guests can access the self-catering kitchen
