Just a few minutes' walk from Stirling Castle on its crag, with great views over the surrounding area. Head downhill and you're right in the city centre with its shops, cafés, restaurants and bars and nightlife.

Rooms

Capacity 92:

- 11 twins
- 1 double
- 14 four-bedded
- 2 six-bedded

All rooms are en-suite (with extra toilet facilities around the building). Family rates/private rooms available. Room configurations may be subject to occasional change

Reception

- Open 24 hours, with a night porter available between 23.00-07.00
- Check-in from 15.00
- Checkout by 10.00

Late arrival and access outside opening hours is by pre-arrangement only

Catering

- Continental and cooked breakfasts and packed lunches are available
- For groups of 20+ we offer the choice of 1, 2 or 3 course dinner menus
- All food is freshly prepared on the premises

- Breakfast is normally served from 07.15-09.00. Dinner is served at an agreed time from 17.00-20.00. Arrangements can be made for alternative times on request
- Groups should reserve meals at the time of booking or at least 4 weeks prior to arrival
- The dining room can accommodate 60 people

Self-catering

- The kitchen is open between 07.00-11.00 and 14.00-23.15 with space for 12 people
- 5 hobs with 20 cooking rings (gas), 2 domestic ovens, 2 fridges (no freezer) and 1 microwave
- Selection of pots to cater for individuals and groups
- Crockery and cutlery available to suit staggered meal times for all guests

Facilities

- Lounge, with TV, can seat 30 people
- 2 coin-operated washing and 2 drying machines are available from 07.00-23.00 (no drying room)

- Towel hire is available
- A conference room, which can accommodate up to 30 people, is available for hire. Please ask the reservations team or youth hostel staff for details
- Free Wi-Fi access

Security

There are swipe card operated locks to the rooms and downstairs corridors

There are lockers in each room - bring your own padlock or buy one at reception. Storage for left luggage is not available

Shopping

The youth hostel does not sell general food supplies; however there are various supermarkets and cafes nearby

There are also vending machines for drinks, snacks and confectionery

We are licensed to sell a range of local beers, cider, wine and whisky

Directions

Bus: from Stirling bus station walk into the town centre. Follow signs for Stirling Castle. The youth hostel is on St John's Street, opposite the Tolbooth

On foot: follow signs for Stirling Castle. The youth hostel is on St John's Street, opposite the Tolbooth

Car: follow signs for town centre and then Stirling Castle. The youth hostel is on the left after the Highland Hotel

Train: from Stirling train station walk into the town centre. Follow signs for Stirling Castle. The youth hostel is on St John's Street, opposite the Tolbooth

Parking

There are 8 car spaces in the car park. Should this be full there is Pay & Display on-street parking. Meter times are from 08.45-06.30

There is no coach parking in the youth hostel grounds, so please arrange this prior to arrival (Stirling Castle offers coach parking)

There is secure cycle storage for up to 10 bicycles at the side of the main building

Local activities

Golf, fishing, hill walking, dry ski slope, football, pool, gym, sailing, cycle paths and bird watching

Non-sporting attractions include pubs, clubs, restaurants and historic interests

Close enough to Edinburgh for the Edinburgh Festival and Glasgow too

Accessibility

Disabled access is all on the ground floor. The disabled access room has 2 beds and en-suite facilities, including a wet room. There is no disabled access to upper floors, TV room or laundry facilities
